


## In 2011, an Ohio law took effect preventing physicians

from using an evidence-based protocol for medication abortion recommended by the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and the World Health Organization.

Women obtaining medication abortion after the law were

3x as likely

to require additional treatments compared to women having medication abortion before the law.



The most common treatment was additional medication or an in-clinic procedure to complete the abortion
